This is a letter to document our findings and recommendations for a lyr 4month Male German Shepherd Dog, who is in the training program of the City of Vacaville Police Department.

He was seen at our facility on Dec 30, 2020 with the chief complaint of possible facial trauma. There were allegations that he had received several punches to the face from his handler on Dec 28, 2020. He seemed to be doing fine and has been eating, drinking, and behaving normally after the incident.

Upon physical examination, the following findings were noted:

Wgt 37 kg T 101.4F HR 124 RR 28 Pink mms.

Bright, alert, responsive, hydrated. He does not exhibit any shyness from hand raising nor does he flinch from bringing my hand up to his face quickly. He loves being petted and rubbed. He leans into me when he is examined. He is excited and friendly to me and my staff. EENT- Stage 1 dental disease. No fractured nor loose teeth. No bruises to the gums. Ears clean. No hemorrhage in either ear canal. Eyes clear. No scleral nor conjunctival hemorrhage. Pupils equal and symmetric. No hyphema. MS - normal gait. No pain along the maxillofacial structures. No temporal pain. No pain upon opening the mouth. CV- no murmurs. Pulses strong. Resp - eupnic. GI/UG no pain in abdomen. No masses. Neuro - normal cranial nerves. No cp deficits. Skin - clean coat. No bruising nor swelling to the skin nor face. No ectoparasites noted. Pain score: 0/9

The assessment was:

No evidence of major injuries that require medical or surgical intervention at this time. The canine officer was cleared to continue training and to go through the Vacaville Police Department evaluation of how their working dogs are trained and corrected.

This is a letter to document our findings and recommendations for a 1yr 4month Male German Shepherd Dog, who is in the training program of the City of Vacaville Police Department who was presented for exam to us today.

He has been boarding at the trainer's facility for approximately 2 weeks, and has been resting, eating, and drinking fine.

Upon physical examination, the following findings were noted:

Wgt 36.8kg T 102.7F, HR 140, RR 80 (panting), Pink mms, CRT 1.5sec. BARH. He doesn't flinch when hands or other objects are presented quickly to his face. He does not react negatively when petted around the head and mouth. EENT- Stage 1 dental disease. No broken teeth. No bruises on gums. Ears clean. Eyes clear. MS - normal gait. CV- no murmurs. Pulses strong. Resp - eupnic. GI/UG no pain in abdomen. No masses. Testicles descended and normal. Neuro - normal cranial nerves. No cp deficits. Skin - clean coat. No ectoparasites noted. Pain score: 0/9

The assessment was:

The patient seems to be in good health with no pain nor behavioral problems that would prevent him from undergoing further training in the City of Vacaville Police canine unit.

This dog is cleared for return to training.
