Course Description: "Canine Liability 360" is still rated by its attendees as the most comprehensive liability course being offered to handlers and K9 supervisors since 2010. This two-day (16 hours) class serves as an essential phase (and required by some agencies) for both the K9 handler and K9 supervisor to assist in managing their K9 program and preparing for their potential "legal defense" in the event of a lawsuit by examining the "360 Degrees of Responsibility" involving a single purpose patrol or cross-trained police dog.
