Completion of the survey will provide vital information for the City's consultant, **Magellan Advisors**, who will conduct a gap analysis and needs assessment based on collected data, paired with an evaluation of available infrastructure that will become the foundation of the City's broadband master plan.

Introduced in January, the City intends to use the plan to prioritize fiber network expansion for:

- Public facilities to ensure continuous connectivity and resilience for essential City functions;
- Improve commercial access to increase economic; and
- Address the digital divide by increasing high-speed internet access for low-income and disadvantaged communities.

The development of a Broadband Master Plan aligns with the City's Strategic Plan Goal #2: Strengthen the Local Economy, Implementation Strategy #4.
