- A. Curb Ramp Request: Markham at Wesley Avenue near the bus stop (Attachment 1)
S. Brown presented a new project request for curb ramps on Wesley Ave. at Markham. Resident requested ramps due to bus stop nearby and no way to access sidewalk. Intersection is located on a curved portion of Markham created additional safety concerns. D. Troxil commented on the safety issues at that intersection due to speed of downhill traffic on Wesley and the nearby intersection of Rocky Hill Road creating hazards for drivers. S. Brown suggested consulting with the City's Traffic Engineering division to have a traffic review conducted before proceeding. Project was prioritized, pending Traffic Engineering Review and Construction quote.
