# WATER CONSERVATION REGULATIONS



Until further notice, the City has enacted Stage 2 of the City's Urban Water Shortage Contingency Plan and implemented the following water conservation regulations.

#### Water Waste Restrictions

- No excessive runoff from outdoor irrigation that leads to water flowing to adjacent properties, private and public walkways
- No washing of sidewalks, driveways, walkways, and parking lots except for removal of hazardous materials for public health and safety
- No washing vehicles, equipment, structures, or other items without using a shutoff nozzle
- No use of fountains and other water-using ornamental structures unless equipped with a recirculating pump

## **Adopted Irrigation Days**

Customers are asked to limit irrigation of outdoor turf to three days per week between 6 PM and 10 AM, as shown below.

## Restrictions on Irrigation of Non-Functional Turf (Commercial Customers Only)

- Irrigation of turf that is strictly ornamental and is not used for any recreational or community purpose will be prohibited
- The following are exempt from these restrictions: Ball fields, schools, parks and turf with trees

### **Conservation Tips**

#### **Around the House**



#### Around the Yard

- Mowing less and planting native lawns and plants
- Utilize drip and micro-spray systems where possible
- Water for shorter periods (i.e., 5-10 minutes) over multiple cycles on designated watering days
- Allowing a minimum of 60 minutes between cycles to maximize soil and root absorption and prevent runoff
