S. Brown presented the proposed project scope to the committee. Given the large number of ramps, a reduced project including 2 ramps at N. Orchard/Crestview and 3 ramps at N. Orchard/Gonzales was presented as an option. Due to limited budget, the reduced project was approved.

B. Curb Ramp Request (2 requests): N. Orchard @ Elder (Attachment 2)

S. Brown presented the request for ramps made by the parent of a student at Willis Jepson Middle School. Both ramps were approved. Motion: D. Medina; 2nd: E. Tonic; Unanimous

Update: 10/10/22: S. Brown followed up with the Committee via email to discuss the ramps at N. Orchard @ Gonzales and N. Orchard @ Elder. N. Orchard @ Gonzales requires additional work beyond the approved scope, including a slurry seal. Public Works is planning to complete a slurry seal project in that area in early summer 2023. The Committee agreed to postpone completion of the project until then to save on project costs and avoid duplicate work. The approved N. Orchard @ Elder project included 2 ramps, however that leaves one curb inaccessible. The Committee opted to complete the third curb as part of the project in order to create a completely accessible intersection.


