

MARKET RATE SENIOR-ONLY APARTMENT VACANCY AND RENT SURVEY ADDENDUM

Results of the 2022 Apartment Rent and Vacancy Survey can be analyzed for senior-only housing. 428 market rate senior-only apartment-type rental units were surveyed. Of the 428 market rate senior-only rental apartment units included in this survey, all 428 were reported. Of the 428 reported, six units were reported to be vacant and available for rent and one unit was reported to be vacant but unavailable for rent. The one unavailable unit was not included in the vacancy rate.

An additional 359 senior-only apartment-type units are not included in this addendum because they have deed restricted, below-market rate rents (See Below-Market Rate Apartment Rent and Vacancy Survey for information on these 359 units). Deed restricted below-market rate rent units are not included because including the lower rents would prevent an accurate determination of median rent levels for market-rate senior-only units.

Vacancy:

- The overall senior-only housing vacancy rate is 1.4%.
- The vacancy rate for one-bedroom senior-only housing units is 0.3%.
- The vacancy rate for two-bedroom senior-only housing units is 4.3%.

The overall market rate senior-only rate has increased since the 2022 survey. The one-bedroom apartment vacancy rates have decreased. The two-bedroom apartment vacancy rates have increased.

Market Rate Senior-Only Rent Survey Results:

- The range of rents for one-bedroom units reported is \$1,434 – 1600.
The median rent for one-bedroom units is **\$1,590**.
- The range of rents for two-bedroom units reported is \$1,626 – \$1,741.
The median rent for two-bedroom units is **\$1,684**.

Market rate senior-only unit median rents compared to market rate non-senior median rents are reflected on this chart.

Non-Senior Median Rent	\$1,805	\$1,800

Market rate senior-only median rents for one-bedroom units are currently \$215 less than market rate. Two-bedroom units are \$116 less. Historically senior-only rents have been lower than non-senior rents.
