Draft Removal Action Workplan for the Proposed 700 Parc on Main Development, Operable Unit 1

WHAT IS BEING PROPOSED? The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is sending out this Public Notice to let the community know about the proposed cleanup at 700 Parc on Main Site (Site). The Site consists of multiple Operable Units (OU); OU1 North, located at 701 Catherine St, OU1 South located at 325 Wilson Street and OU2 located at 201 McClellan Street, Vacaville, CA 95688. Phase 1 would encompass OU1 North and OU1 South. In March 2022, an environmental investigation was completed at the Site and found lead and low levels of organochlorine pesticides in surface soils at various locations across the Site. The contamination likely comes from the demolition of residential structures and buildings with lead paint and pest control activities. The proposed cleanup would include the excavation/removing lead-contaminated soil from the Site to allow for residential and commercial redevelopment.

CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA): In compliance with the CEQA, the City of Vacaville adopted the East Main District Mixed-Use Development Project Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) which determined that the proposed project along with mitigation measures would not result in a significant environmental impact. DTSC has reviewed the IS/MND, concurs with the findings for the project, and finds the Mitigated Negative Declaration to be the appropriate document to address CEQA. DTSC will file a Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research/State Clearinghouse upon the RAW approval.
