BELOW MARKET RATE APARTMENT VACANCY AND RENT SURVEY ADDENDUM

Results of the February 2024 Apartment Rent and Vacancy Survey can be analyzed for below market rate housing. 1,419 below market rate apartment rental units were surveyed. 419 senior-only below market rate apartment units are not included in this survey, however, comparisons are made between non-senior below market rate units and senior-only below market rate units at the end of this addendum.

Of the 1,000 below market rate non-senior rental apartment units included in this survey, 1,000 responded to the survey. Of the 1,000 units that were reported, 38 were reported to be vacant and available for rent and 14 were reported to be vacant but unavailable for rent. The 14 unavailable units are not included in the vacancy rate.

Vacancy:

- The below market rate vacancy rate is 3.8%.
- The vacancy rate for one-bedroom units is 4.9%.
- The vacancy rate for two-bedroom units is 3.7%.
- The vacancy rate for three-bedroom units is 2.3%.
- The vacancy rate for four-bedroom units is 3.6%.
