City of Vacaville to Begin Jepson Parkway Phase II Construction Project April 29

Construction focused on Leisure Town Road between Elmira Road and just south of The Mission Church

VACAVILLE, Calif. – April 29, 2024, marks the launch of the second phase of the City of Vacaville's comprehensive Jepson Parkway Construction Project beginning at the intersection of Elmira Road and Leisure Town Road. Construction will continue north toward Ulatis Creek and The Mission Church with anticipated completion in late 2025 (total construction will take approximately 15 months). The community should anticipate delays when traveling through the area and adjust accordingly.



Please follow posted detours and travel with care.

Mitigated impacts:

- Businesses along Leisure Town Road will be open during construction.
- Road access will be maintained to businesses and the surrounding residential communities.
- Play4All Park will remain open during construction.
- The City sent more than 5,000 mailers to residents and businesses along the Leisure Town Corridor, and notified Travis Air Force Base Public Affairs.
- The City's consultant, KMP Strategies, visited approximately 35 businesses in the Commerce Place and Union Way Area, and 13 homes who back to the construction.

Once complete, Vacaville and Solano County residents will have an improved intra-county throughway with an end goal of reduced congestion from Interstate 80. Major roadway improvements will:

- Develop a safe, efficient transportation network for the movement of people and goods within Solano County;
- Protect residents living adjacent to roadways from the impacts of existing and anticipated traffic levels using landscaping and noise buffers;
- Provide interconnected traffic signals using advanced transportation methods at major junctions to improve access and safety;
- Provide efficient City streets to serve local trips that currently require using Interstate 80;

- Improve emergency vehicle access and transit services; and
- Increase transit support and enhance pedestrian, motorist, and transit user safety.

The City's Jepson Parkway Project – a 12-mile multi-modal corridor – is a visionary solution to the congestion and mobility issues affecting Solano County and the I-80 corridor. Once complete, Vacaville and Solano County residents will have a better intra-county throughway and experience less congestion from Interstate 80. The complete 12-mile Jepson Parkway project is divided into a total of 10 segments for design and construction purposes; five of those segments lie within the City of Vacaville along Leisure Town Road, three of which have already been completed.
