4th of July Celebration in Downtown Vacaville

VACAVILLE, Calif. – The City of Vacaville Parks and Recreation Department is pleased to announce the free 4th of July celebration with a concert and fireworks display, scheduled for Thursday, July 4, 2024. Download the smartphone Japa app to locate available parking in downtown.

Vacaville's free 4th of July celebration will be held at the CreekWalk Plaza at Andrews Park. Music starts at 6:30 p.m. Join your neighbors and friends to celebrate America with live entertainment, vendors, great food, and a spectacular fireworks display.

Kicking off the night will be music from Groove Ride followed by fireworks.

No outside alcohol or glass containers are allowed. No smoking, no weapons, no tents, no early drop-off of chairs and blankets, and no pets (service animals are permitted). Lawn chairs, blankets, and water in small coolers **no larger than 16 quarts** will be permitted.

Remember that in the City of Vacaville, all fireworks, including safe and sane, are illegal. Be safe and leave the fireworks to the pros. We've got trained pyrotechnics and fire personnel on hand to ensure a safe fireworks experience for everyone.

Road closures for this event are as follows: Davis, Main, E. Main, McClellan, Merchant, School and Wilson streets will be closed at 5:00 PM. Monte Vista between Dobbins & Markham streets will be closed at 8:00 PM. All streets will reopen following the conclusion of the fireworks show. Please note that if a Red Flag Warning is in effect the fireworks portion of the evening will be cancelled for safety.
