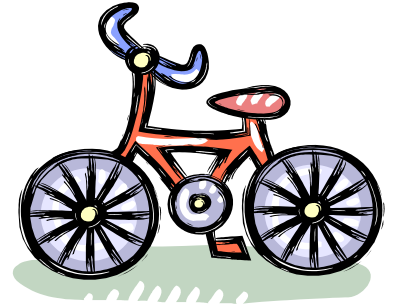


# Saturday, March 28, is the Community Bike Drive!!!
